



Your visitor visa application was approved

Understand your visa conditions

The new visitor visa label inside your passport has the details of your visa.

VISA EXPIRY	The last day you can stay in New Zealand.
FIRST ENTRY BEFORE	The last day you can make your first entry into New Zealand.
EXPIRY DATE TRAVEL	The last day you can enter New Zealand.
NUMBER OF ENTRIES	If your visa states you have <i>Multiple</i> entries, you may re-enter New Zealand as many times as you want before your EXPIRY DATE TRAVEL.
VISA CONDITIONS	You must abide by these conditions. You must have a ticket to leave New Zealand when you travel, unless your visa states <i>Return/onward travel not required</i> .

You must hold a valid visa at all times while in New Zealand

If your visa expires and you have not departed, you will be in New Zealand unlawfully and will be liable for deportation.

If your plans change and you need to stay longer

We encourage visa holders in New Zealand seeking further temporary visas to apply at least one month in advance of their expiry date. You can now apply for certain categories of visitor, work and student visas online.
